<sup>NKJ</sup> **Genesis 1:9** Then God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be **gathered** (qavah) together into one place, and let the dry *land* appear"; and it was so.

<sup>NKJ</sup> **Matthew 4:8-11** Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. <sup>9</sup> And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me." <sup>10</sup> Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.'" <sup>11</sup> Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him.



<sup>NKJ</sup> **Jeremiah 31:1** "At the same time," says the LORD, "I will be the God of all the families of Israel, and they shall be My people." <sup>2</sup> Thus says the LORD: "The people who survived the sword Found grace in the wilderness -- Israel, when I went to give him rest." <sup>3</sup> The LORD has appeared of old to me, *saying*: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you. <sup>4</sup> Again I will build you, and you shall be rebuilt, O virgin of Israel! You shall again be adorned with your tambourines, And shall go forth in the dances of those who rejoice.



<sup>5</sup> You shall yet plant vines on the mountains of Samaria;  
The planters shall plant and eat *them* as ordinary food.  
<sup>6</sup> For there shall be a day *When* the watchmen will cry  
on Mount Ephraim, 'Arise, and let us go up *to* Zion, To  
the LORD our God.' " <sup>7</sup> For thus says the LORD: "Sing  
with gladness for Jacob, And shout among the chief of  
the nations; Proclaim, give praise, and say, 'O LORD,  
save Your people, The remnant of Israel!' <sup>8</sup> Behold, I  
will bring them from the north country, And gather  
them from the ends of the earth, *Among* them the  
blind and the lame, The woman with child And the one  
who labors with child, together; A great throng shall  
return there.





<sup>9</sup> They shall come with weeping, And with supplications I will lead them. I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters, In a straight way in which they shall not stumble; For I am a Father to Israel, And Ephraim *is* My firstborn. <sup>10</sup> " Hear the word of the LORD, O nations, And declare *it* in the isles afar off, and say, 'He who scattered Israel will gather him, And keep him as a shepherd *does* his flock.' <sup>11</sup> For the LORD has redeemed Jacob, And ransomed him from the hand of one stronger than he. <sup>12</sup> Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, Streaming to the goodness of the LORD -- For wheat and new wine and oil, For the young of the flock and the herd; Their souls shall be like a well-watered garden, And they shall sorrow no more at all.



<sup>13</sup> "Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, And the young men and the old, together; For I will turn their mourning to joy, Will comfort them, And make them rejoice rather than sorrow. <sup>14</sup> I will satiate the soul of the priests with abundance, And My people shall be satisfied with My goodness, says the LORD." <sup>15</sup> Thus says the LORD: "A voice was heard in Ramah, Lamentation *and* bitter weeping, Rachel weeping for her children, Refusing to be comforted for her children, Because they *are* no more."



<sup>16</sup> Thus says the LORD: "Refrain your voice from weeping, And your eyes from tears; For your work shall be rewarded, says the LORD, And they shall come back from the land of the enemy. <sup>17</sup> There is **hope** in your future, says the LORD, That *your* children shall come back to their own border.
