What Does It Mean?


The rabbis say:

"The Holy One, blessed be He, said to Israel, 'My children, I know that during all seven days of the Feast of Tabernacles you have been occupied with offerings in behalf of the nations of the earth. But let this day be a day of rejoicing solely for you and Me. I shall not ask you for too burdensome an offering -- only one bullock and one ram." *Pesikta Rabbati 52.7*



Hebraic Time Line




7 = the Number of Completion

8 = New Beginning


- Firstborn brought for an offering


City of Gold

Of the 613, at least –

- 18 pertain to death (murder, manslaughter, punishment, etc.)
- 16 pertain to war
- 33 pertain to the temple / tabernacle
- 101 pertain to sacrifices
- 27 pertain to the priests
- 7 pertain to the king

If these laws are going to pass away (because they are no longer needed) –

Could not the Sabbath and Holy Days pass away also, since we have now **entered the Rest** pictured by Shabbat?

For if Joshua had given them rest, then He would not afterward have spoken of another day. ⁹ There remains therefore a rest for the people of God. ¹⁰ For he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his works as God did from His.
