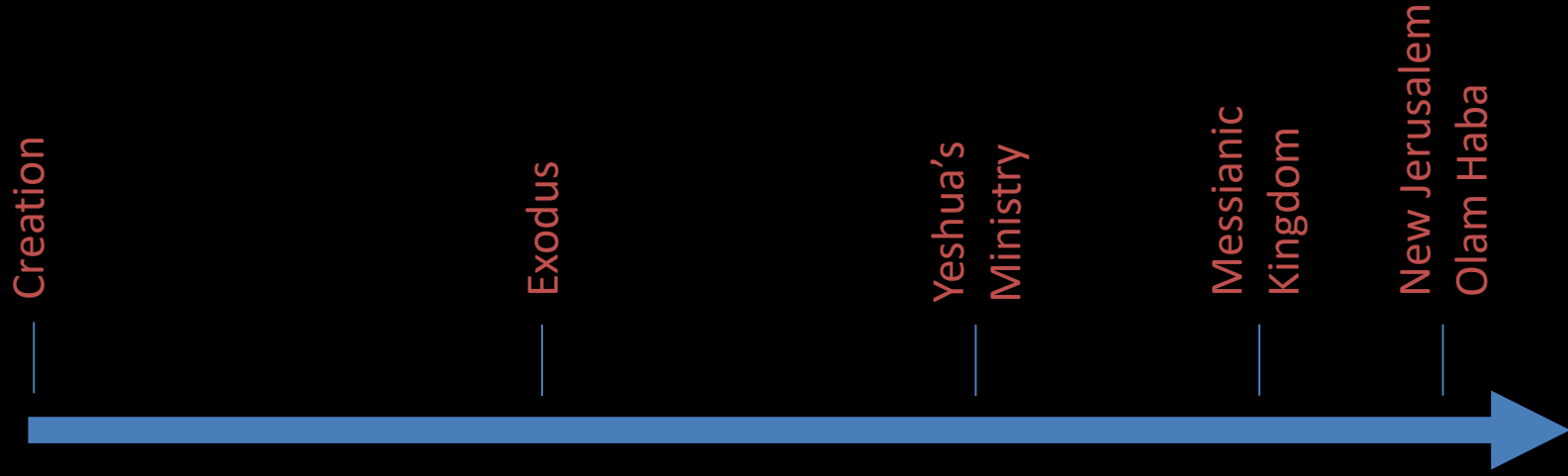

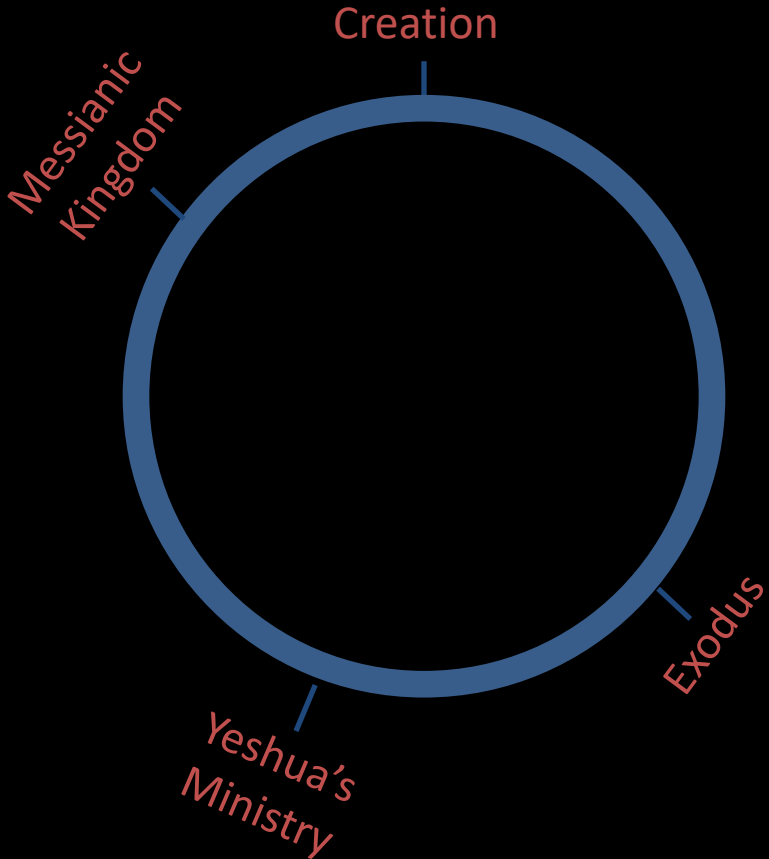

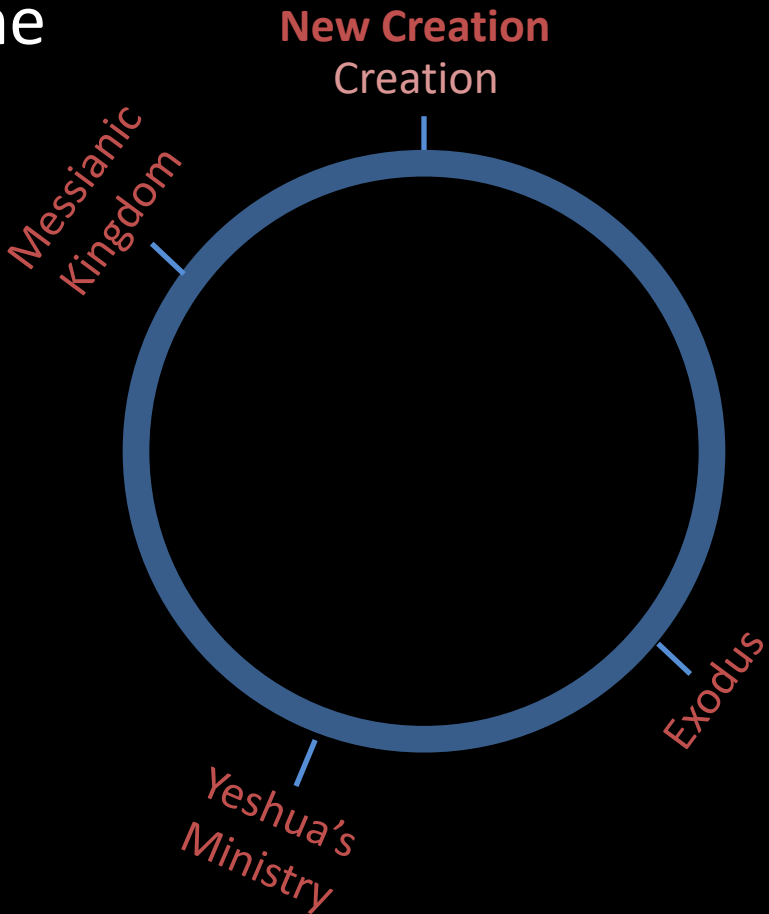
# Typical “Greek” Timeline



# Hebrew Timeline

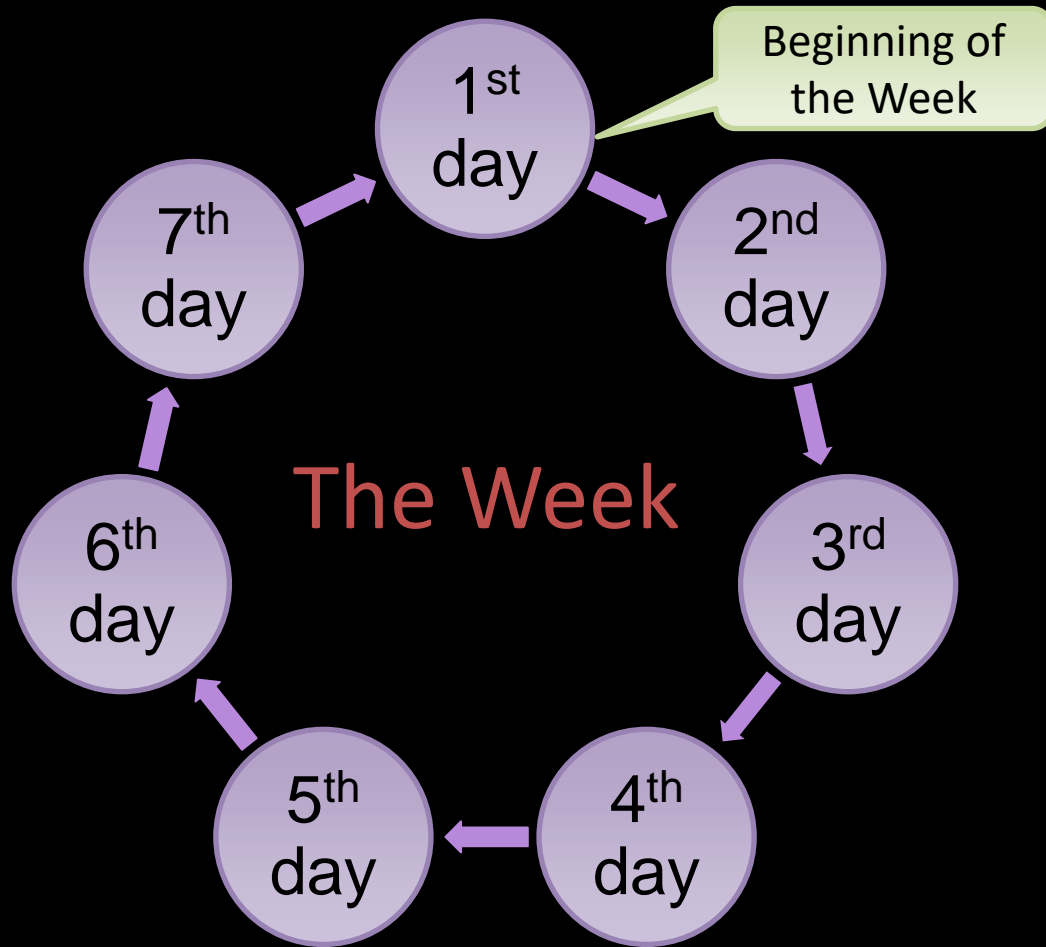

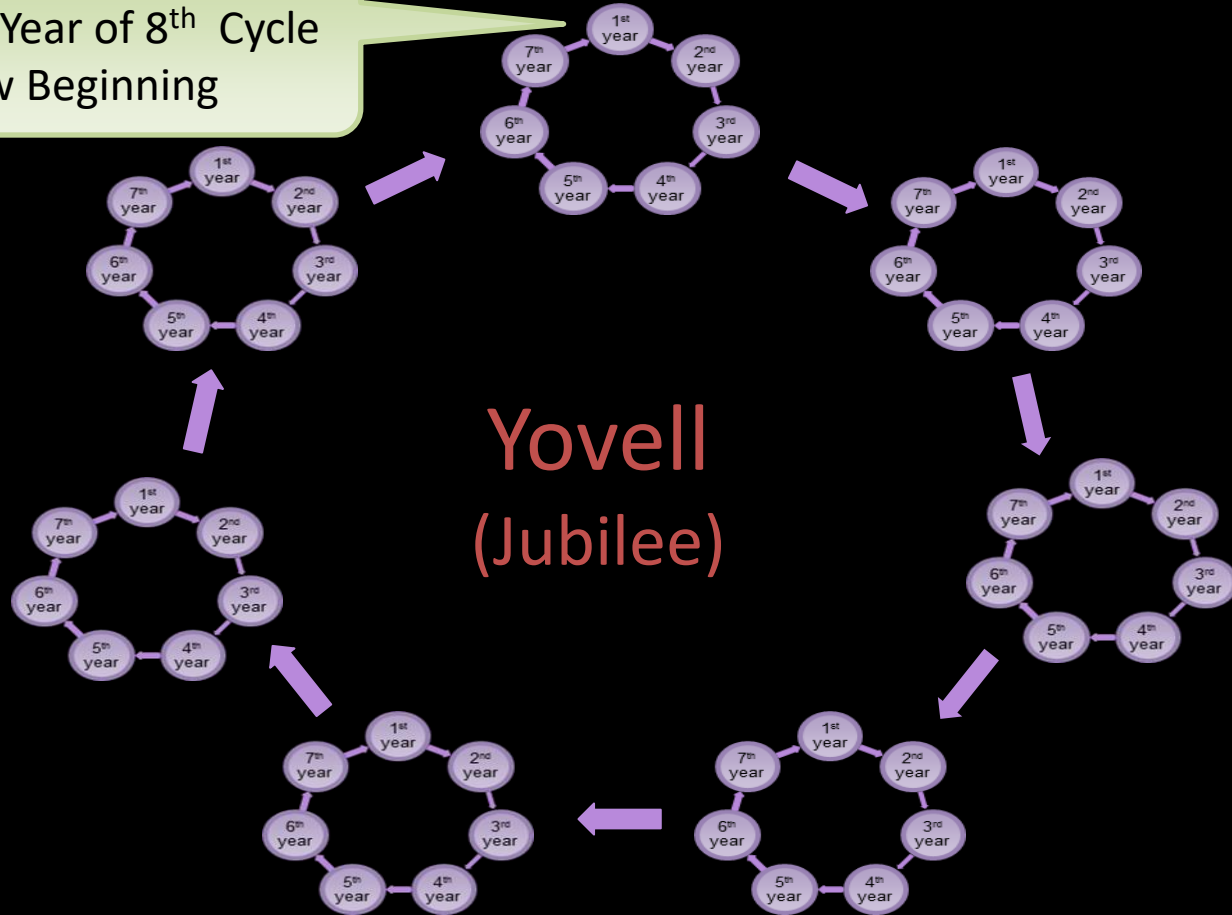
- Circumcision (Lev. 12:3)

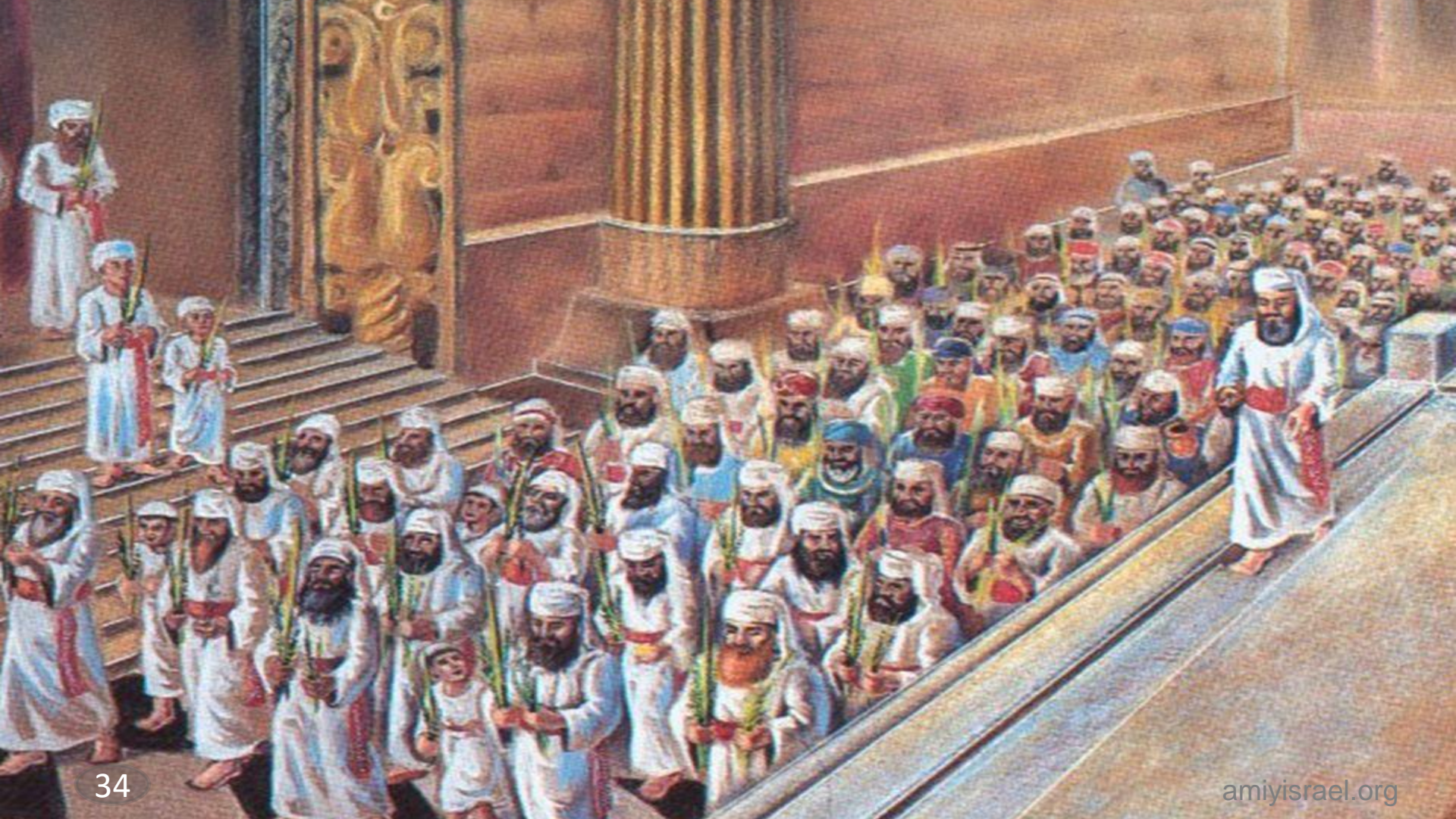
ESV **Psalm 118:25-29**
