- Yom 3117 Din-day, time, year; day (as opposed to night); a day as defined by evening and morning; a division of time
- Teruah 8643 אור בו alarm, signal, sound of tempest, shout, shout or blast of war or alarm or joy
- Ruah 7321 ∑¹¬ to shout, raise a sound, cry out, give a blast; to shout a war-cry or alarm of battle
- Shofar 7782 ๅีวฺ่าัซ่ horn, ram's horn
- Chuppah 2646 กิฐิกิ a wedding chamber



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

¹³ But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep . . . ¹⁵ For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. ¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

The Kingdom - a Wedding Chamber:
